

Edgecombe County Polling Places  
For November 8, 2016 General Election and One Stop Voting

The Board of Elections defines the voting place for all precincts as the building in which voting occurs. The 50-foot buffer zone is used for all precincts except Precinct 1-4. It is measured from the door of the building that is used for entry by the voters. Electioneers may place signs and distribute campaign literature any place outside of the buffer zone, but must not block the path into the building. The Board does not limit the location of electioneering outside the buffer zone, but encourages campaigners to consider their safety and the safety of voters when selecting the placement of their personnel. Also the buffer zone will apply to all one-stop voting sites in the County.

In precinct 1-4 the buffer zone is measured at 48 feet, which ends at the corner of the building. Electioneers should use the grassy area between the building and the parking lot.

Mondays thru Thursdays; and Friday, October 28<sup>th</sup> and Friday, November 4<sup>th</sup> the hours are 1:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. The sixth site is the Speed Volunteer Fire Dept., 113 Mill Pond Road, Speed, NC. The hours of operation for the weekdays are 1:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Both sites hours are 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. for Saturdays, October 22<sup>nd</sup>, October, 29<sup>th</sup> and November 5<sup>th</sup>.
