In addition to the ongoing opportunities to recycle at our landfill and convenience sites, and the annual clean-up and recycling events we sponsor in partnership with the local chapter of Keep America Beautiful, we're planning to do even more to Keep Edgecombe Clean and Green.

What You Can Do Now!

We are encouraging individuals, local organizations and volunteer groups to join in with us. Here are some things that you can do:

- Don't be a litter-bug! Respect your community by properly disposing of trash and recyclables;
- Keep your property and surrounding areas clean by doing regular trash pick-ups. The tipping fee will be waived for trash brought to the landfill as a part of a community or road side clean-up;

- Call us to report roadways and community areas that could use a volunteer clean-up crew; and
- Sign-up as an individual or group to be included on a register of volunteers to help with community clean-ups.
