REQUIREMENTS FOR MARRIAGE LICENSE

Acceptable proofs of identity

1. Valid Drivers License or valid state issued picture I. D.
2. Valid Visa/Immigration Card
3. Valid Passport
4. Valid Government or military issued I. D.
5. Certified Birth Certificate issued by a government agency in the U. S., a U. S. territory or Canada or U. S. Report of Consular Birth Abroad (Persons under 21 will also need a certified Birth Certificate. Persons 16-17 will need parent's signature. All parties must provide proper identification.)

Acceptable proofs of Social Security

1. Original Social Security Card
2. Current pay stub
3. Current tax W-2 form
4. Valid Insurance card with SSN
5. Signed Social Security printout
(If you are not eligible to obtain a Social Security card, you will be required to provide a sworn notarized affidavit stating that. You will also be required to show proof of an Individual Taxpayer Number (ITIN) issued by the IRS. Only IRS-issued documents may be used for proof of ITIN.)

If last marriage ended by death or divorce within the last year, you will be required to provide a certified death Certificate or divorce decree.

Altered documents will not be accepted.
